Directions To Garden State Archers

Larrison Road, Jacobstown, NJ About a ¼ mile on left off Rt. 537 after you cross over Rt. 528 follow Larrison Road about a ½ mile on the left across from golf course. Coming west on Rt. 537 it is a ¼ mile before you get to Rt. 528 you make a right onto Larrison Road follow it about a ½ mile club is on the left across from golf course.

Rules for the State Championship:

- 1.) This is a one day shoot.**
- 2.) You must declare which day you intend to shoot, or you can shoot both days, but must be declared.**
- 3.) Fee: \$25.00 adults. If you shoot same division both days, \$25.00. If you shoot both days in different divisions, \$50.00.**
- 4.) If you shoot both days (in the same division), only your high day will count.**
- 5.)Format: 14 Field, 14Hunter, 14 Animal**
- 6. All SFAA & NFAA Styles & Classes & Rules apply**
- 7. Traditional Archers only shoot 50 yds and less**
Now That the SFAA has changed the distance that you shoot there may be a chance for you being a state champion come on out and try it.
- 8. As of June 1st there are a few changes which needed to be added Cub, Youth, Young Adult are now able to shoot in Bowhunter Freestyle Division. Master Seniors are able to shoot in Bowhunter Freestyle, Freestyle Limited Recurve,Bowhunter,Traditional, Longbow and Bowhunter Freestyle Limited. There has been a new Division Added Silver Senior 60-69 will shoot all the same Division as Adults, Seniors and Master Seniors. Also the age has been changed in Senior from 55-65 to 50-59 and in the Master Senior from 65 and up to 70 and up.**
